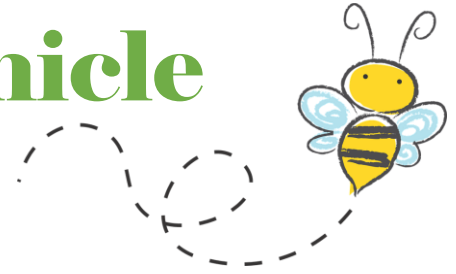


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Bees! by Brandon

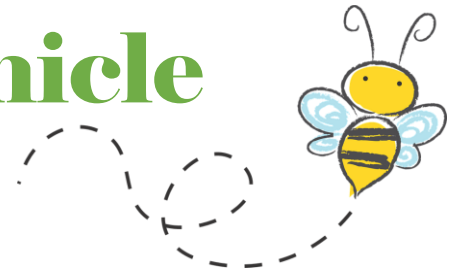
1. What is your first name? "Sheldon."

My name is Tanner Munn. I'm 7 years old. I'm good at math. My favorite thing is pottery. I'm a history buff.

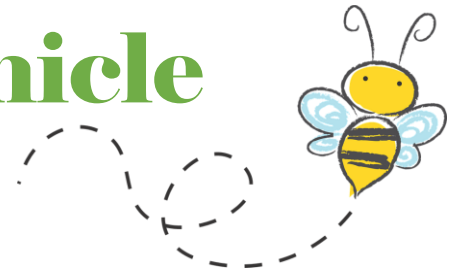
4-H

We Had a Barclay Brings a Buddy to School Day by Naomi

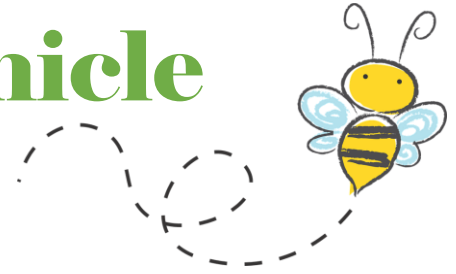
